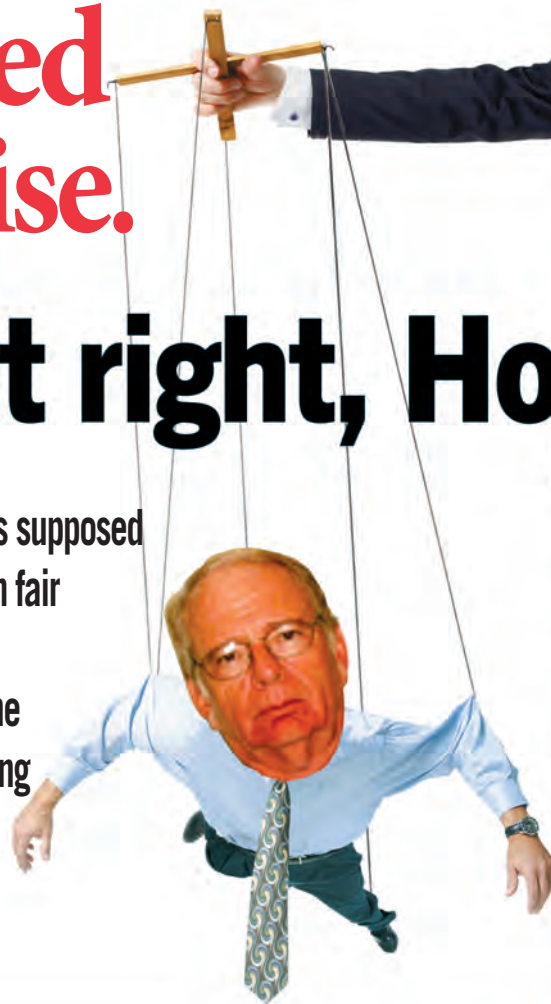


**The cops
